Sealed bids are invited from reputed companies / carriage contractors who are:

- Registered with Income Tax Department (ATP) & PRA (Punjab Revenue Authority)
- Have at least 3-5 years' experience in the field of goods transport preferably with any
 well reputed FMCG company

The bid shall comprise of a single package containing two separate envelopes.

- Each envelope shall contain separately the financial proposal and the technical proposal;
- The envelopes shall be marked as "FINANCIAL PROPOSAL/RATE LIST" and "COMPANY PROFILE" in bold and legible letters to avoid confusion.
- Initially, only the envelope marked "COMPANY PROFILE" shall be opened
- The envelope marked as "FINANCIAL PROPOSAL/RATE LIST" shall be retained in the custody of the Tendering committee without being opened.

- 2. Loads may varies depending upon, NHSO ordinance 2000.
- 3. Preferably, container body vehicles/ closed body will be preferred
- 4. Given vehicles LADEN LOADS approved capacities must be matched with SFPL loading standards/capacities.
- 5. All Type of Loading will be done on Daily basis from 4km Lahore Road Jaranwala Plant on daily basis as per SFPL requirement.
- 6. Stations list, Profile and Terms & conditions are available on web site and can be downloaded from (http://www.shakarganjfood.com).
- 7. Transporter will be responsible to arrange vehicles & lift stock as per ordering and vehicle requirement on same day. No delay will be acceptable.
- 8. SFPL requires total of approx. <u>30-40 Vehicles per day</u> (depending on business percentage & daily allocation), for any geographic area across Pakistan having 450+ distribution & sub-distributions (includes AJK, FATA, & GB)
- 9. Transporters must have enough financial muscles to invest Rs 100-120 Million as running Finance (without CAPEX investments) to meet the vehicles requirement.
- 10. Company may issue FUEL CARDS (of any OMC's) against monthly Billing (as per company Policy)
- 11. Each transporter will quote rates for all stations (List available at (http://www.shakarganjfood.com) on their Letter heads and for all types of vehicles.
- 12. Applications with incomplete rate list /partially filled rate list will not be accepted for tendering process.
- 13. Each Company will enclose, <u>Demand Draft of Rs 20,000</u> in favor of Shakarganj Food products limited <u>(non-refundable)</u> along with formal Bid. In case of Non-Compliance, Bid will not be accepted for further process.
- 14. Contract will start from Jan 1, 2026 for a period of 2 Years (extendable).



- 15. Contract may be cancelled/terminated due to unsatisfactory performance within first 03 months without prior Notice.
- 16. SFPL will have full rights to charge FINE/Penalty in case of any delay in vehicles/violation of rules & regulation
- 17. Each Company will enclose following documents along with Application,
 - Company Profile
 - Pool Vehicle List
 - Reference Client List
 - NTN
 - PRA Registration Certificate
 - Active Tax Payer Certificate
 - Experience Letters from existing/previous clientele. FMCG working experience will be preferred (e.g. Tetra Pak)
 - Details of all bank account numbers
 - Bank statement for Last 01 year
 - Other (as per Check List)
- 18. Rate will be fixed for <u>contract period</u> (Except fuel adjustment as per SFPL Formula) and no adjustments will be given on special occasions (Moharram/Eid/Shortages in Market)
- 19. All Type of Toll taxes, Token fee, will be borne by transporter and will not be liable to claim from SFPL (Except Permit fee if any for tribal area)
- 20. In case Contract is awarded, Transporter will deposit Security of <u>Rs 5 million</u> in SFPL Bank account before contract initiation <u>(Refundable)</u>. Same amount will be adjusted in ledger balance within <u>90-120 days</u> of clearance/NOC from all concerned departments (This is only for newly selected transporter).



- 21. Vehicles conditions will be as per SFPL standards. Broken, dented floor vehicles, over/under size vehicles will not be accepted for loading at SFPL.
- 22. All vehicles must have registration certificates, valid route permits & valid fitness certificates.
- 23. Vehicles sizes will be as per SFPL requirement & standard against each load category.
- 24. All drivers must have valid computerized driving license otherwise; vehicle will not be allowed to enter in SFPL premises.
- 25. SFPL can load more than one station load in single vehicle to make vehicles capacity full utilization.
- 26. For single load, double station load will be applied as half of the total amount.
- 27. Transit insurance will be responsibility of SFPL (As Per SFPL Insurance Policy) following the **LADEN Weight policy**.
- 28. All type of leakages, damages, losses, shortages, or any other transit loss will be borne by respective transporter.
- 29. SFPL will not pay any type of vehicles detention charges in any case across the Pakistan
- 30. Transporter will submit original receiving (Delivery note), duly signed & stamped from respective distributor along with Invoice.
- 31. Transporter will provide daily vehicles tracking report and send to SFPL Logistics department for receiving confirmation purpose
- 32. Bills without proper delivery note acknowledgment will not be entertained for payment
- 33. Transporter will be responsible to submit bills on weekly basis.
- 34. Verification of bills will be as per SFPL SOP that will be shared (On contract award basis only)
- 35. WHT deductions from payments will be made as per Government applicable laws.



- 36. Sealed quotes, clearly mentioning on envelop <u>"Quotation for Transport Services"</u> will be sent to given address mentioned in advertisement within due date.
- 37. Incomplete/ partially filled application/ tender will not be accepted and not be included in final Tender Process.
- 38. Application received after due date will not be accepted and will not be the part of final Tender Process.
- 39. Detailed terms & conditions will be the part of final contract
- 40. The SFPL reserves the right to accept or reject all or any of the bid/proposal in accordance with the provision of SFPL Rules & criteria and no claim whatsoever is this regard shall be entertained
